The Morland SCD Weeks

2023 will see the 14th of our d-i-y SCD Weeks, following the 21 years of weeks with John Drewry. These weeks are intended for experienced dancers: there will be no step or formation tuition so a good knowledge of SCD is essential.

Workshops and dances

For those who have not been on the d-i-y weeks, we need to explain that all the teaching and dance instruction is done by the participants attending the week. All who run the workshops and dances are experienced dancers/ teachers.

All the dancing is in Morland Village Hall.

For the evening social dances, we are delighted that Chris and Julie Dewhurst will be here again to play for us. The evening dance programmes will be circulated in time for you to have a look at them and (possibly) practice them.

For the morning workshops, the teachers arrange for their own recorded music. It goes without saying that the music is of the highest quality and is thoroughly danceable!

Programme

As ever, we will start the week on the Bank Holiday Monday evening, with workshops for all on the Tuesday, Thursday and Friday mornings.

This year we will have a **new Wednesday pattern**. Workshops are on offer in the morning for those who would like them. There is also the possibility of a local minibus tour, led by Neil Hannah, either all day or perhaps just in the afternoon. The cost of these will depend on demand, but we anticipate that the cost of an afternoon-only trip will be around £10 each, with an all-day trip around £15 each. Please indicate on the Application Form what you think you might be interested in.

Our final dance will be on the Friday evening, but most people will want to stay over until the Saturday.

On the Wednesday evening, after the dance, we will have a social evening in the Music Room at Newby End Farm to give us a chance to get to know each other better.

Coronation of King Charles III

For the rest of the week, dinners are available at £16.00 each. You don't necessarily need to book for the whole week, but at least 24 hours' notice would help the caterers.
